OBJECTIVES, INITIATIVES & ACTIVITIES

- 1 To develop and promote sports (in particular rugby) and recreation, mainly for the benefit of previously disadvantaged children, and to provide related facilities.

An amount of **R200 000** was allocated/spent towards the fees of professional coaches and conditioning experts as well as other professional services rendered to the beneficiaries of the Foundation.
- 2 To provide hostel accommodation to students of public benefit organisations.

An amount of **R100 000** was allocated to accommodate boys in the hostel during training camps. The amount covered all meals as well. An additional amount of **R495 000** was paid to cover the hostel fees of nine students.
- 3 To provide scholarships, bursaries, awards and loans for study, research and teaching.

An amount of **R805 000** was allocated to benefit 18 boys in terms of scholarships for school, tour fees and extra academic classes. Congratulations to the four grade 12 students of 2023 on their excellent results. They all met the minimum requirements for admission to a bachelor's degree.
- 4 To implement community development and anti-poverty initiatives.

An amount of **R100 000** was allocated towards the Forward Foundation with which we have partnered. They have been doing upliftment projects in the rural areas of Strand, Lutzville, Piketberg, Riversdal and Grabouw. They also hosted a showcase clinic at their annual Sevens Invitational, held at the Markötter Grounds of Paul Roos Gymnasium, which featured top performers from their clinics.



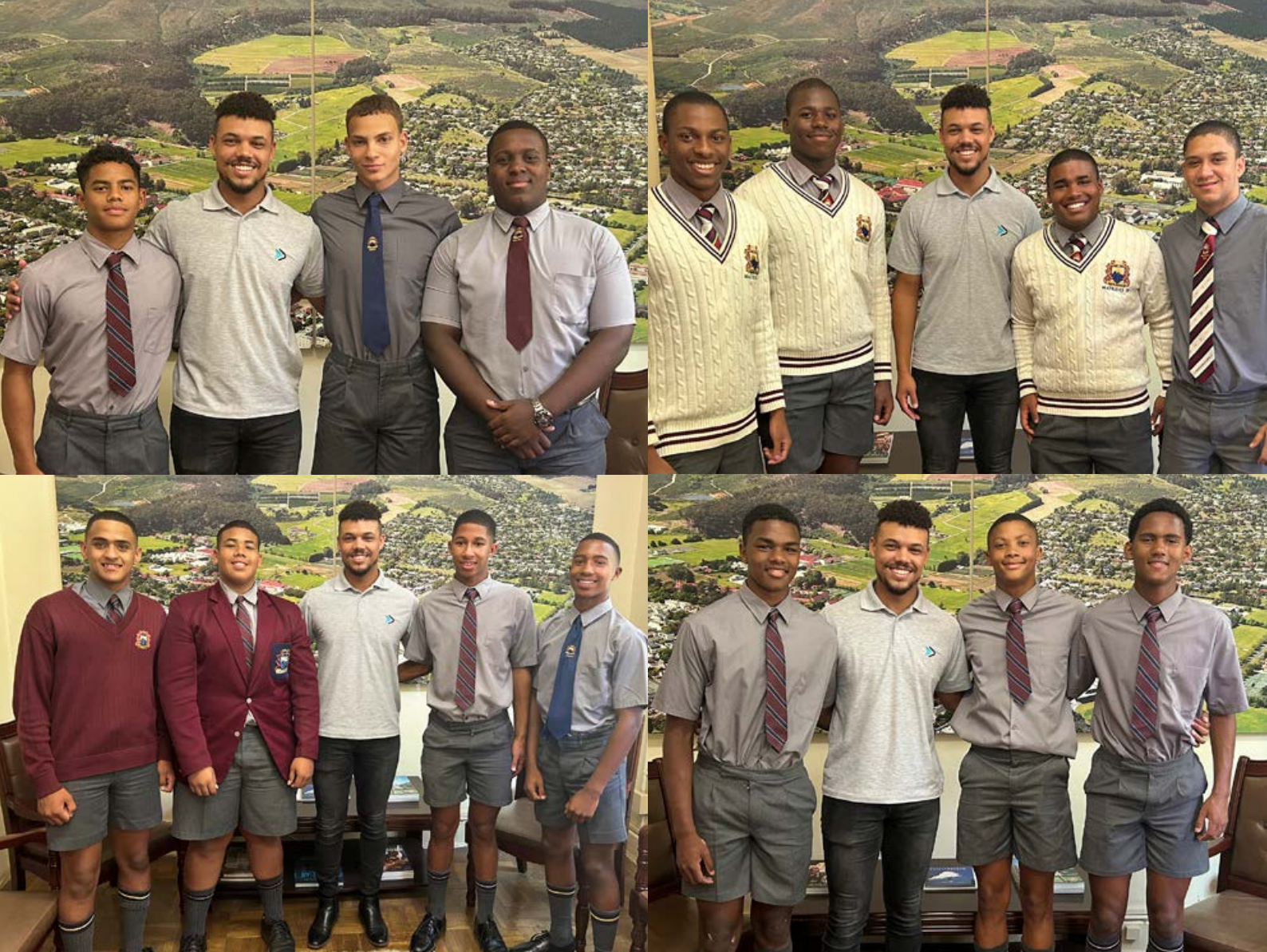

The PRG Foundation is incorporated as a non-profit company (NPC) in terms of the South African Companies Act (Act 71 of 2008) under registration number 2018/634706/08. The company qualifies for and was also granted tax-exempt status by the South African Revenue Service. This further authorises the company to issue qualifying donors with Section 18A receipts which could be utilised as a deduction against income for income tax purposes.

In addition, the tax status and objectives of the company allow benefactors of the Foundation to accumulate corporate social investment (CSI) points for broad-based black economic empowerment (BBBEE) scorecard purposes.
